The Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) International Program is pleased to announce three full fee-waiver scholarships for international students entering the full-time International BBA Program for the Fall 2017 semester.

1. Scholarships are open to international high school students. Scholarship applicants must achieve a combined old SAT score or CU-AAT score of not less than 1300 or new SAT score of not less than 1360.
2. Applicants must be international students who have foreign passport or Thai students who have dual passports.
3. Applicants selected must be listed on the Chulalongkorn University Final Applicant Selection Announcement for the Academic Year 2017, confirm and report their decision to the BBA Office, and pay the confirmed and preparatory course fee (as specified in the Faculty Announcement on Procedures for Final Selection and Admission to the Bachelor of Business Administration International Program, Academic Year 2017).
4. Applicants selected must meet and fulfill all enrollment requirements, as outlined in the 2017 Chulalongkorn University Admissions Announcement.
5. The eligible applicants must obtain the GPA of no less than 3.0 in the first semester in order to maintain the scholarship in the next semester.

If the selected applicant does not meet the requirements or declines the scholarship, the standing ranking next on the Final Selection Announcement list who has met Requirements above will be considered for receiving the scholarship.

This scholarship exempts the recipient from payment of tuition and special fees only for the first year of the study in the International BBA Program.
