## Admission Information in accordance with Chulalongkorn University Announcement on Temporary Workplace Closure as a Result of COVID-19 Infection Outbreak

The application packet must be sent later by registered mail to Bachelor of Business Administration International Program 4th Floor, Building 8, Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy, Chulalongkorn University, Phayathai Road, Bangkok 10330 with no postmark later than March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
- 2) The applicants who took the SAT exam on 14 March 2020, you must e-mail the evidence of your SAT score to narisara@cbs.chula.ac.th and cc photipong@cbs.chula.ac.th for recording your SAT score in the application system no later than March 30<sup>th</sup> Then, applicants can check in the online application system to see if the score has been recorded. After the score has been recorded in the system, applicants are required to follow what it is described in point 1 above. (Please be noted that we will receive another evidence of your SAT score from the SAT organization (the CollegeBoard) later).
