The BBA International Program will grant scholarships for full tuition and special fees for the Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters as per the following qualifications:

- 1. Applicants must be a Thai nationality.
- 2. Applicants with the three highest ranking by SAT score (Math and Evidenced Based Reading and Writing) accepted to the BBA International Program, as listed on the Final Selection Announcement for the Academic Year 2021, will be awarded scholarships. In case there is more than one Announcement, the ranking will be done across all Announcements. And/or applicants with SAT score (Math and Evidenced Based Reading and Writing) used in the application of 1500 or above.
- 3. Recipients selected need to confirm and report their decision to the BBA Office and pay the confirmation fee as specified in the Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy Announcement
- 4. Recipients selected must fulfill all enrollment requirements, as outlined in the Announcement from Chulalongkorn University used for the admission.
- 5. Recipients selected must obtain the Grade Point Average (GPA) of no less than 3.00 in each semester in order to receive the scholarship in the next semester.

If the selected recipient does not meet the requirements or declines the scholarship, the next highest ranking student (by the SAT score (Math and Evidenced Based Reading and Writing)) on the Announcements referred to in point 2, who has met all the qualifications above, will be considered for receiving the scholarship.

This scholarship is for the tuition and special fees only in the first academic year.
