

**Admission Information in accordance with Chulalongkorn University Announcement on
Admission to the Bachelor of Business Administration International Program
Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy
for the Academic Year 2022 (Early Admission) “BBA – NextGen Admission” (Additional)**

Reference is made to the Chulalongkorn University Announcement regarding Admission to the Bachelor of Business Administration International Program, Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy, for the Academic Year 2022 (Early Admissions) “BBA – NextGen Admission” on 19 October 2021.

For the purposes of clarity in using ACT as the academic aptitude test for early admission 2022, “BBA – NextGen Admission” it is therefore deemed appropriate to repeal item 1.3 in Chulalongkorn University Announcement regarding Admission to the Bachelor of Business Administration International Program, Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy, for the Academic Year 2022 (Early Admissions) “BBA – NextGen Admission” on 19 October 2021, and replace it by the following statement:

1.3 Applicants will be evaluated on their ability to communicate in English and their Mathematic proficiency from any one of the following test:

- CU-AAT (Chulalongkorn University Academic Aptitude Test) organized by the
Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center
(Math Section and Verbal Section) not lower than 1230 **OR**
- SAT (Math and Evidence-Based Reading and Writing) not lower than 1300 **OR**
- ACT Composite score (Mathematics, English, Reading and Science) not lower than 28

In submitting the scores of CU-AAT (Math Section and Verbal Selection) or SAT (Math and Evidence-Based Reading and Writing) or ACT Composite (Mathematics, English, Reading and Science) test scores must be taken on the same date.
