



Chulalongkorn University Announcement
to international students (non-holders of the Thai passport) or Thai students
(who are holders of duo passports) for admission to the Bachelor of Business Administration
International Program Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy
for the academic year 2026

The Chulalongkorn University Board of Governance has authorized the Bachelor of Business Administration International Program, Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy Program, to select **international students (non-holders of the Thai passport) or Thai students (who are holders of duo passports)** to admit to the following two majors in the Academic Year 2026:

- International Business Management major
 - Digital Business Management field
 - Financial Analysis and Investment field
 - Brand and Marketing Management field
- Accounting major

Admission Criteria:

1. Applicant Requirements

- 1.1 Applicants must be international students who have a foreign passport or Thai students who have dual passports.
- 1.2 Applicants must not be younger than 17 years old and must have completed/be completing M6 or its equivalent levels in Thailand.
- 1.3 Applicants who obtain a high school diploma from the English speaking countries are waived from submitting the English proficiency test scores. (See the countries list in the attached document)
- 1.4 Applicants must achieve the minimum score on one of the following English proficiency tests:
 - TOEFL (Internet-based) not lower than 79 OR
 - IELTS (Academic) not lower than 6.5 OR
 - CU-TEP & Speaking not lower than 101 (for the same test date) OR
(Chulalongkorn University Test of English Proficiency)
 - GaoKao Score of English Language not lower than 100 (out of 150)
- 1.5 Applicants will be evaluated on their ability to communicate in English and their Mathematic proficiency from any one of the following tests:
 - CU-AAT (Chulalongkorn University Academic Aptitude Test) organized by the Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center (Math Section and Verbal Section) not lower than 1200 OR
 - SAT (Math and Evidence-Based Reading and Writing) not lower than 1270 OR



- GaoKao Score of Mathematics

not lower than 80 (out of 150)

To submit the scores of CU-AAT (Math Section and Verbal Selection) or SAT (Math and Evidence-Based Reading and Writing) or GaoKao (English and Mathematics) the test scores must be from the exam on the same date. All scores according to 1.4 and 1.5 must be for examinations taken within two years of the application date. The applicants must submit the electronic exam results according to the instructions specified under Items 4.6

2. Number of Available Places

The Bachelor of Business Administration International Program (International Business Management major and Accounting major) is authorized to admit up to **twenty-five (25) qualified applicants**.

3. Application Schedule and Application Fee

3.1 Application Schedule

3.1.1 Apply online at <http://admission-bba.acc.chula.ac.th/>. There are two rounds of application as follows;

First round application: December 22th 2025 – 6th February 2026

Second round application: March 20th – May 1st 2026 (The second round of application will take place on the condition that the announced number is not met in the first round.)

3.1.2 Application Fee Payment

For the first-round application, please pay the fee between December 22th 2025 – February 6th 2026

For the second-round application (if any), please pay the fee between March 20th – May 1st 2026

Payment can be made through one of the following methods:

1. Credit card payment (Bank charge on your own). **or**
2. Scan QR Code (for Individuals use). **or**
3. Payment via K PLUS application : Scan the barcode on the payment form. **or**
4. Payment via K PLUS application: Manually enter information as indicated on the payment form ;
 - Select "Payment" transaction.
 - Choose "Services" and search for "COM.&ACC.CHULA"
 - Enter Reference 1 and Reference 2 according to the payment form. **or**
5. Take the payment form and make the payment at any branch of Kasikorn Bank. Ensure that the document is stamped by Kasikorn Bank as proof of payment.

3.2 Application Fees

The application fee is 1,500 Thai baht (transaction fees and surcharges are not included).

4. Application Package

Applicants must complete all required sections in the online application system and must ensure that all the information given is true and correct. All application forms must be accompanied by the following (scanned or electronic documents submitted in the online application system):



- 4.1 Application card with two one-inch (1) photographs.
- 4.2 A certified copy of the official letter from the applicant's school certifying their current academic status (for those currently studying) or a certified copy of the academic certificate (for graduate students). The copy must be signed and certified as a true copy.
- 4.3 A certified copy of academic transcript or graduation certificate. The copy must be signed and certified as a true copy.
- 4.4 Copies of exam results as specified in requirements 1.4 and 1.5 above. The copy must be signed and certified as a true copy.
- 4.5 A copy of the applicant's passport. The copy must be signed and certified as a true copy.
- 4.6 Submit electronic exam results according to requirement 1.4 and 1.5 above:
 - 4.6.1 If an applicant selects the **TOEFL**, the result must be sent by ETS directly to the Bachelor of Business Administration International Program. Please use the code for the Chulalongkorn **BBA 4559**
 - 4.6.2 If an applicant selects the **IELTS exam**, the result must be sent by British Council or its testing center directly to the Bachelor of Business Administration International Program. Please use the code for the Chulalongkorn **BBA 138499**
 - 4.6.3 If an applicant selects the **SAT Exam**, The electronic SAT result must be sent by the College Board directly to the Bachelor of Business Administration International Program. Please use the code for the Chulalongkorn **BBA 4559**.
 - 4.6.4 If an applicant selects the **CU-AAT, CU-TEP & Speaking exam**, the original score report issued by Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center must be submitted. The score report can be obtained at Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center, 3rd floor Chamchuri 8
- 4.7 A copy of the proof of payment of the application fee (the applicant's portion, stamped by Kasikorn Bank Public Company Limited, or proof of payment through other specified methods according to item 3.1.2, clearly showing the applicant's full name). The copy must be signed and certified as a true copy.

Incomplete application packet will not be considered.

5. Selection Process Details

5.1 First Round Application

5.1.1 Evaluation Criteria for Interview Shortlist

Each application will be evaluated on the admission criteria and test scores according to requirement 1.5 by Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy.

5.1.2 Interview Shortlist Announcement

Applicants short-listed for the interview will be announced on February 11th, 2026 at the website: <http://bba.acc.chula.ac.th>

5.1.3 Interview (Online)

Applicants qualified for an interview will be hosted online between February 17th – 19th, 2026. If an applicant does not report for interview, that applicant will be disqualified.



5.1.4 Evaluation Criteria for Applicants to be selected

Applicants will be evaluated on their admission criteria and test scores according to requirement 1.5 The applicants must pass the interview conducted in English arranged by the Bachelor of Business Administration International Program, Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy.

5.1.5 Announcement of Selected Applicants

Selected applicants will be announced on February 24th, 2026 on the website <http://bba.acc.chula.ac.th>

5.1.6 Enrollment Confirmation with Payment

The admitted applicants must confirm their decision for enrollment online at <http://admission-bba.acc.chula.ac.th/> by paying the confirmed fee from February 26th – March 3th, 2026 (within 12.00 hrs.). Failure to do so will result in official rejection from the Program.

5.1.7 Additional Enrollment Confirmation with Payment (If Any)

The Additional selected applicants who passed the interview will be announced in order to reach the intended number of admitted applicants. The additional selected applicants must confirm their decision for enrollment online at <http://admission-bba.acc.chula.ac.th/> by paying the confirmed fee from March 4th - 9th, 2026 (within 12.00 hrs.). Failure to do so will result in official rejection from the Program.

5.1.8 Announcement of Applicants who have Confirmed Acceptance of Offer of Place and Paid for the Admission Confirmation Fee

The Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy will announce the list of applicants who have confirmed acceptance of offer of place and paid for the admission confirmation fee by email between February 27th – March 10th, 2026.

Successful applicants who have confirmed acceptance for the offered places and paid for the admission confirmation fee will not be eligible for the second-round application. The Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy reserves the right not to refund the application fee to applicants.

5.2 Second Round Application (If Any)

The second round of application will take place on the condition that the announced number is not met in the first round.

5.2.1 Evaluation Criteria for Interview Shortlist

Each application will be evaluated on the admission criteria and test scores according to requirement 1.5 by Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy.

5.2.2 Interview Shortlist Announcement

Applicants short- listed for the interview will be announced on May 7th, 2026 at the website: <http://bba.acc.chula.ac.th>

5.2.3 Interview (Online)

Applicants qualified for an interview will be hosted online between May 11th - 15th, 2026.
If an applicant does not report for interview, that applicant will be disqualified.



5.2.4 Evaluation Criteria for Applicants to be selected

Applicants will be evaluated on their admission criteria and test scores according to requirement 1.5 The applicants must pass the interview conducted in English arranged by the Bachelor of Business Administration International Program, Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy.

5.2.5 Announcement of Selected Applicants

Selected applicants will be announced on May 19th, 2026 at the website <http://bba.acc.chula.ac.th>

5.2.6 Enrollment Confirmation with Payment

The admitted applicants must confirm their decision for enrollment online at <http://admission-bba.acc.chula.ac.th/> by paying the confirmed fee from May 21th – 26th, 2026 (within 12.00 hrs.). Failure to do so will result in official rejection from the Program.

5.2.7 Additional Enrollment Confirmation with Payment (If Any)

The Additional selected applicants who passed the interview will be announced in order to reach the intended number of admitted applicants. The additional selected applicants must confirm their decision for enrollment online at <http://admission-bba.acc.chula.ac.th/> by paying the confirmed fee from May 27th June 1st, 2026 (within 12.00 hrs.). Failure to do so will result in official rejection from the Program.

5.2.8 Announcement of Applicants who have Confirmed Acceptance of Offer of Place and Paid for the Admission Confirmation Fee

The Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy will announce applicants who have confirmed acceptance for the offered places and paid for the admission confirmation fee by email between May 22th – June 2nd, 2026

6. Announcement of Applicants with the Right to Study (from the first and second round applications)

Chulalongkorn University will announce applicants with the right to study the for the Bachelor of Business Administration International Program, Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy Program, for the 2026 academic year (international round) on June 10th, 2026 on the website <http://bba.acc.chula.ac.th>

7. Enrollment Conditions

7.1 To be eligible to enroll for the first registration as University students, enrollees must have completed M6 or its equivalent level. In case the University later found out that the applicants have not graduated or cannot fulfill any requirement of the admission criteria, the eligibility to of applicants for the enrollment shall be void and the University reserves the right not to refund application fee, confirmation fee, and tuition fee in any case.

For the ones who graduated from international schools in Thailand or from overseas, which are not certified by the Ministry of Education of Thailand. It is required to get a high school equivalence certificate according to the Council of University Presidents of Thailand regarding the criteria on a high school equivalence certificate for the Thai University Central Admission System. 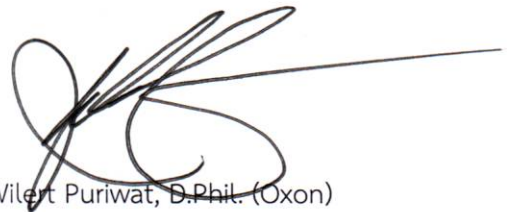
